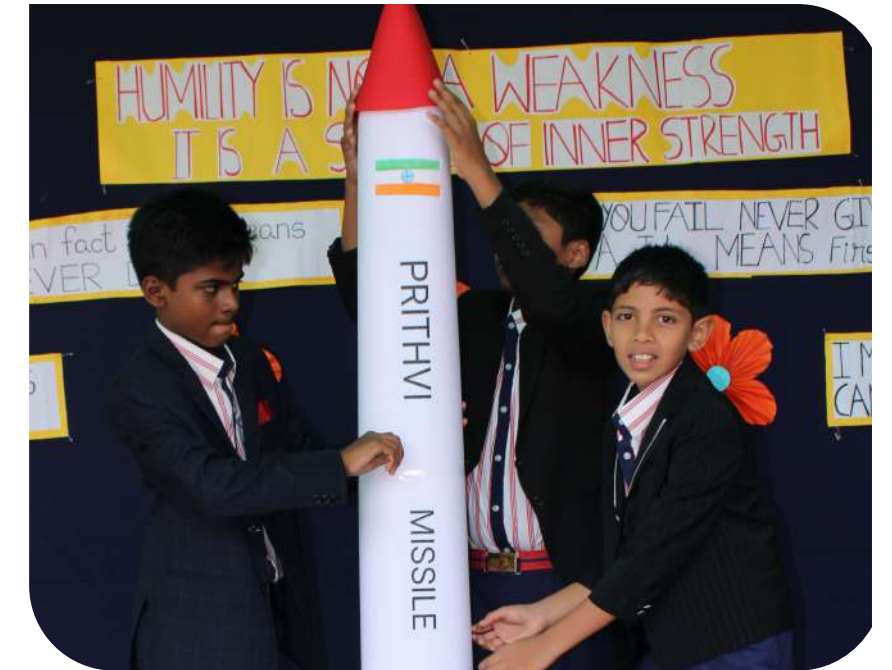

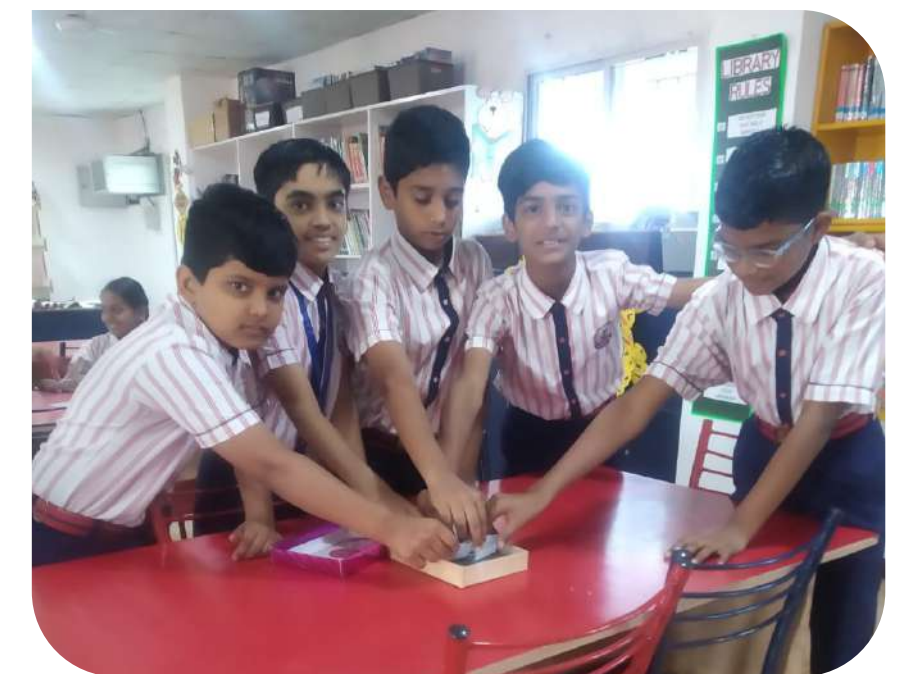

## National Road Safety Week

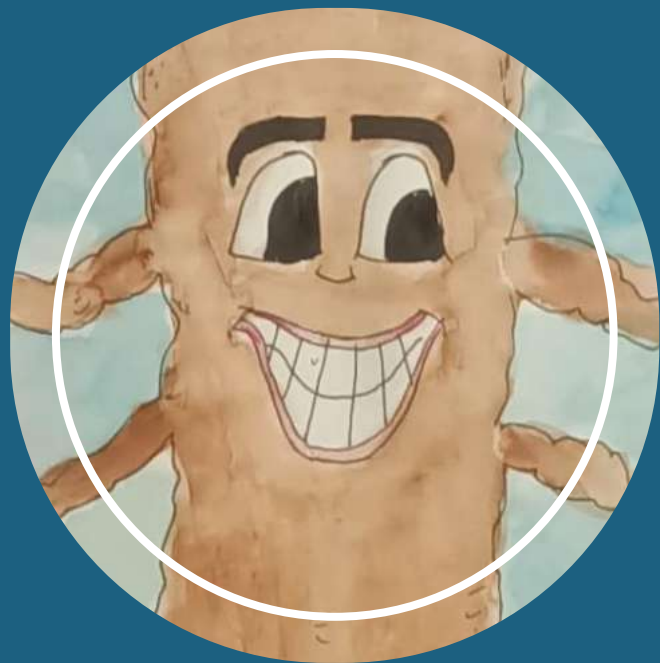
